


Here is a selection of websites which may be useful to support your child with learning to tell the time from an analogue clock; it is by no means exhaustive!

This game has three levels of difficulty.

Level 1 focuses on 'o'clock', 'quarter past' / 'quarter to' and 'half past';

Level 2 focuses on telling the time to five minutes, along with Level 1 time language;

Level 3 focuses on telling a mixture of 'minutes past' and 'minutes to' the hour.

Move the clock hands to the correct time and watch the mouse run and catch the cheese!
