### Validation of Reporting Lines and Timekeeper Groups

#### Validation of Timekeeper Groups and Reporting Lines

A key driver of EA One functionality is the data relating to the hierarchies of staff and the teams they sit within. The EA One Project team has contacted schools to **validate timekeeper groups** i.e. who *inputs and submits timecards* on behalf of staff and to **validate reporting lines** i.e. to inform who will approve Self-Service requests, e.g. annual leave requests. Determining the appropriate line management for each employee is key to putting in place proper controls, and in maintaining employees' data security.

To help minimise the input required from individual schools, the project is using existing data to propose hierarchies and timesheet groups for each school. If this logic applies to your school, you will not need to do anything. However, if your school is set up differently there will be a requirement to work with the Project to capture exceptions.

### EA One Regional School Engagement Sessions

The Project is running one hour, live virtual engagement sessions approx. three months before each regional payroll moves to the new system. These engagement sessions will be targeted at **timecard inputters and submitters** within schools.

The engagement sessions for Belfast and Omagh took place on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> and Monday 21<sup>st</sup> June, and have been recorded and made available on the [EA One Hub](#) for those who were unable to attend the live sessions.
